
**Three Biblical Words for Pastor**

Character Commitments of a Pastor
Sober Minded = Level Headed, Steady
Self Controlled = Acts w/ Understanding
Respectable = Well Ordered, Put Together
Hospitable = Friend to Outsiders
Able to Teach = Well, You Know
